



Grade Recovery Plan for AHS & AMS

ACS Families,

We understand the impact the COVID-19 closures have left on many of our students, especially those who wished to improve their grades over the remainder of the year. That's why we're implementing our grade recovery plan for all students at Arlington Middle and Arlington High to help them improve their 3rd quarter grades!

The State Board of Education granted local districts the ability to provide the opportunity to recover grades prior to March 20th. All students in grades 6-12 can choose to opt into grade recovery for the 3rd quarter. There will be no 4th quarter grade. **These opportunities are optional. Students are not required to participate in the grade recovery plan.**

How It Works

Students are allowed to recover up to three grades in each subject or course. In order to opt into the grade recovery plan, students **must** email the teacher of each subject they would like to recover grades. The teacher(s) will then work with students individually to determine which three assignments can be completed for grade recovery.

Participating in the grade recovery plan **cannot** harm students. The grade recovery assignment(s) will only replace the original grade if it's higher. Otherwise, the original grade will stand.

Students will have the ability to recover grades on **up to three** assignments as indicated below:

- Students may complete **one** grade recovery assignment in a course's highest weighted category. Students may redo the assignment or complete a similar assignment that assess the same standards and skills as the original assignment.
- Students may also complete **two** grade recovery assignments from the course's lower weighted categories. Students may redo the assignment or complete a similar assignment that assess the same standards and skills as the original assignment.
- **It is at the teacher's discretion whether to allow a redo of an assignment or if a similar assignment will be assessed.**

Students are not required to recover all three assignments; it's the student's choice to complete one, two, or three grade recovery assignments.

Deadlines

- Students must opt in to the grade recovery plan by May 4, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. in order to participate.
- All seniors must turn in their grade recovery assignments by May 8, 2020 at 4 p.m.
- All other grades (6-11) must turn in their grade recovery assignments by May 13, 2020 at 4 p.m.
