Summer Assignment Description

Students are to read a free digital book *Blown to Bits: Your life, Liberty, and Happiness After the Digital Explosion*. For each chapter, students are responsible for answering questions about the reading. These questions should be answered in complete sentences, typed, and properly labeled on another Word or Pages document. To assist with the reading, students will be given a vocabulary list. Those vocabulary words will be quizzed on at the beginning of the school year and the completed questions will be turned in for a grade.

Friday, August 18; however, students may email me prior their completed questions. Their vocabulary quiz will be near the end of the first week of school.

Estimated Time for Completion

Less than or equal to a week to read, answer questions, and learn vocabulary
